ANC MAPA MUNDI—WHERE SEATTLE COMES FROM

All Nations Cup, a multicultural soccer tournament and arts festival taking place this June, needs your help! With a focus on the celebration of cultural diversity in the Puget Sound, All Nations Cup, founded by the local nonprofit Sister Communities, is constructing a Mapa Mundi (World Map) to visually display the diversity of our community. The map will be comprised of photos donated by people from throughout Seattle's immigrant communities to commemorate their memories and their rich cultural backgrounds that they have brought with them.

Mapa Mundi will be constructed in the form of a global quilt, with shape of the continents formed by photos. The 12-by-21 foot map will be displayed throughout the Seattle area before being displayed at All Nations Cup on **June 6th-June 22nd** at Starfire Sports Complex in Tukwila.

To create the Mapa Mundi, we need people from throughout Seattle's rich multicultural communities to donate photos of their memories from their homelands. We want to share their memories of parties, weddings, picnics, funerals, family and friends that they left behind in starting a new life in the United States. We are looking for photos from all communities—Asian, African, Latin American, European—wherever you come from, share your memories with us. These memories represent who we are as individuals and what we bring to our community.
