Rules:

Players selected by coaches independently of heritage.

10 (max 12) players per time.

2 halves of 20 min - 5 min break at half time.

Ties decided by toss of a coin on first round.

Ties decided on penalty kicks from semi-finals on. At the finals, if we have time left, 10 min – 5 and 5 - of over time, silver or golden goal rule.

No slide tackles, no body charges (to prevent injuries and take advantage away from older kids).

No walls. Games played within the boundaries of the dotted line.

Balls that hit the “post” decided by referee (maybe we play with no posts around the goals? It hits the wall is out? Open to your opinion. Open to your opinion on everything, actually).

FIFA soccer rules prevail apart from items above.
